1	Lucy Johns	<p>Hi everybody, this is Lucy Johns. I really appreciate all the work that Rim put into his slides which I did not have the opportunity to review before this meeting. And so, there’s a lot of comments I would like to make on them, which I will do eventually. But I did want to call attention to one of the bullets, Rim, which talked about ‘must use XDR’. I really would hope that you would rethink that. The Direct network does not use XDR and some people would call XDR almost a legacy protocol. So, I don’t remember the exact wording of that bullet but maybe it should be more permissive rather than obligatory and/or talk about other things that must be used.</p> <p>I would also comment, I listened very carefully to the first hour, hour and a half, and I have a lot of comments as a consumer about obligations of participants to do this or that with respect to protecting the consumer, getting consent from the consumer and so forth. And I sort of wish that there were more consumer comments within this group. I really appreciate the gentlemen from the Electronic Frontier Foundation who often voices questions and thoughts that I had. But you’re not really getting, from my point of view, the consumer point of view in these discussions, so I will do my best to respond, and I hope that you will seek more information and responses from consumers as you move through your process. Thank you.</p>
