1	Lucy Johns	I want to refer to a very California-specific case with respect to Information Exchange. I have recently been released from prison. I am seeking a job. California law, I believe, prohibits a potential employer from asking about prior imprisonment. The employer that I’m talking to is a hospital, a participant under this law. Could a hospital query the criminal justice system about my history there? I don’t need an answer right now, but it’s the use case that I’ve been thinking about throughout this conversation.
2	Lucy Johns	There are many provisions here that require the use of XDR, and it’s my impression—I’m not a lawyer— that the law we’re operating under specifies that it’s supposed to be technology-agnostic. There are national networks that don’t use XDR, so why is XDR referenced as being required?
