We suggest that Signatories review the P&Ps to determine how best to meet their obligations and what capabilities nationwide networks/frameworks may provide to assist them. HIOs qualified through the QHIO program have signed the DSA, have committed to complying with the P&Ps, and have been assessed to offer sufficient capabilities so that their participants can use them to comply with DxF data sharing obligations.

The deadline to begin exchange under the DxF is Jan 31, 2024 for most signatories; some mandated Participant types have until Jan 31, 2026 per AB 133 (such as but not limited to physician practices of fewer than 25 physicians and critical access hospitals).</p>
