1	L. Johns	Yes, thank you. This is Lucy Johns. I'm a consumer of healthcare services here in California. I raised a question in the -- in the Q&A concerning use of out of state services, and QHIOs responding to that. I just want to verbalize that question with the hope that it would be addressed in a systematic fashion somewhere. Thank you.
2	Dan Chaves	Dan Chaves serving Communities Health Information Organization, Santa Cruz, California. Two things, a request and a related question. I think we're far enough along now with our evolution on the data exchange framework to make a request to do a crosswalk between data exchange framework requirements and CalAIM requirements. Many of us in the ecosystem are busy implementing CalAIM, and it'd be helpful to know that there is some synchronization between the requirements. Secondly, and related, there are several references in CalAIM to HIE participation and HIE and the like, and if CDII would be so kind as to request whether these references to HIE -- make a request to DHCS whether these references will be changed to HIO or QHIO and what the timeframe for those changes in that documentation will be. Thank you.
3	Dr. Adam	This is Dr. Adam Damson. I'm here in my role at Sutter Health, as a physician who helps with interoperability issues. The timing of this is becoming more and more of a challenge for our healthcare centers. As you guys
