The Vision for Data Exchange in California

Once implemented across California, the Data Exchange Framework (DxF) will create new connections and efficiencies between health and social services providers, improving whole-person care.

The DxF is California's first-ever statewide Data Sharing Agreement (DSA) that requires the secure and appropriate exchange of health and human services information to enable providers to work together and improve an individual's health and wellbeing.

QHIO P&P - Finalized (1 of 1)

CDII has finalized the QHIO P&P, incorporating feedback received in public comment and previous meetings of the IAC and DSA P&P Subcommittee.

P&P Topic	Purpose
QHIO	This policy establishes the Qualified HIO program, which will, among other things, establish the requirements an Intermediary must satisfy to be designated as a Qualified HIO.

Updates to Published P&Ps

Process for Amending the DSA

CDII is updating the *Process for Amending the DSA* P&P to establish a more streamlined approach for making administrative changes to the DSA and to remove the requirement that signatories re-execute the DSA if it is amended.

Purpose

The Process for Amending the DSA P&P describes the processes by which CDII will solicit, consider, and/or implement amendments to the DSA.

What is changing?

- 1. Administrative Changes CDII is implementing the proposed changes to this P&P as discussed during the IAC meeting on June 5th, 2023 to allow administrative changes¹ to the DSA to ensure administrative consistency across the DSA and all P&Ps. Participants will have the opportunity to object to an "administrative change" during a 10-day public comment period. Standard procedures for amendments (e.g., consultation with a task force) will not be required.
- **2. Execution of Amendments** As discussed during the IAC meeting, the *Process for Amending the DSA* P&P will be revised to remove the requirement for Participants to execute amendments to the DSA.

¹Definition of Administration Change

An "administrative change" refers to any change that does not have a material impact on Participants, and would include, but not be limited to, changes to the definitions in the DSA to ensure consistency with the Policies and Procedures.

Updates to Published P&Ps

Development of and Modifications to P&Ps

CDII is amending the *Development of and Modifications to P&Ps* P&P to establish a similar streamlined process for making administrative changes to P&Ps.

Purpose

The Development of and Modifications to P&Ps P&P describes the processes by which CDII will develop new P&Ps and modify existing P&Ps.

What is changing?

1. Administrative Changes CDII is amending this P&P to allow administrative changes to P&Ps to be approved on an expedited timeline. The definition of 'administrative change' is aligned between the amendments of both this P&P and the Process for Amending the DSA P&P. Participants will have the opportunity to object to an "administrative change" during a 10-day public comment period.

Under Development

Overview

The Glossary of Defined Terms includes the definitions used in the Data Sharing Agreement (DSA) and its Policies and Procedures. These definitions have been aggregated in the Glossary as a central library of defined terms for those seeking such a reference. This glossary is a 20-page document that currently includes 70 definitions.

Components of the DxF P&P Glossary

1. Term

The word or phrase that is defined in the DSA and/or P&Ps.

2. Definition

The meaning of each term.

3. Document Index

Lists all the documents where a term is referenced.

DSA P&P Glossary: Updated Definitions (Draft)

Background

During the aggregation of these definitions, some minor adjustments were made to align terms that did not alter the terms' meanings. However, a few definitions required updates to refine their meanings. These updates were more significant and are described in the following slides.

Glossary Terms with Significant Updates

- 1. Health and Social Services Information
- 2. Individual / Individual User/ Recipient of Services
- 3. Participant
- 4. Personal Representative



Health and Social Services Information

Updated for clarification

Original Definition

HSSI shall mean any and all information received, stored, processed, generated, used, transferred, disclosed, made accessible, or shared pursuant to this Agreement, including but not limited to: (a) Data Elements as set forth in the applicable Policy and Procedure; (b) information related to the provision of health care services, including but not limited to PHI; and (c) information related to the provision of social services. Health and Social Services Information may include PHI, PII, deidentified data (as defined in the HIPAA Regulations at 45 C.F.R. § 164.514), anonymized data, pseudonymized data, metadata, digital identities, and schema.

New Definition (Draft)

HSSI means any and all **individually identifiable** information received, stored, processed, generated, used, transferred, disclosed, made accessible, or shared pursuant to the DSA including but not limited to: (a) data elements as set forth in the applicable Policy and Procedure; (b) information related to the provision of health care services, including but not limited to PHI; and (c) information related to the provision of social services. **Health and Social Services Information may include PHI, PII, and digital identities.**



Individual

Several redundant terms were merged into a single definition

Original Definitions

- Individual means a specific person that is the subject of Health and Social Services Information being Accessed, Used or Disclosed.
- Individual User shall mean the person who is the subject of PHI or PII.
- Recipient of Services means a patient or person who is the recipient of services, including Social Services.

New Definition(Draft)

Individual means a specific person that is the subject of Health and Social Services Information being Accessed, Used, Disclosed or Exchanged.



Participant

Necessitated an update to include all DSA signatories and their subordinates

Original Definitions

Participant(s) shall mean each health care organization as set forth in California Health and Safety Code § 130290(f) and any other person or organization that is a signatory to this Agreement. Participants may include, but are not limited to, a health information network, a community information exchange, a laboratory, a health system, a health IT developer, a community-based organization, a payer, a government agency, a research institute, or a Social Services Organization.

New Definition(Draft)

Participant(s) means each organization that is a signatory to the Data Sharing Agreement, including any identified subordinate entities of a signatory.



Personal Representative

Updated for clarification

Original Definitions

Personal Representative shall refer to a person who, under Applicable Law, has authority to act on behalf of an individual as set forth in 45 C.F.R. § 164.502(g).

New Definition(Draft)

Personal Representative means a person who, under Applicable Law, has authority to **make health care decisions** on behalf of an Individual as set forth in 45 C.F.R. § 164.502(g) **and Health and Safety Code § 123105(e)**.
