I just wanted to make the comment that I find it surprising that we continue not to discuss governance. We saw, 2 attempts in the legislature to create a government structure this year. And the only thing they have in common is they both went down. And it would seem that this time, and you know now that the governor has completed his work, signing or vetoing bills, and before the beginning of the next legislative session would seem a good time to have this conversation. And with all of the influential organizations represented both at this table and then in the public listening in to build some consensus that might make the legislative path a little bit easier for governance when we begin the 2024 session. And yet we haven't done so. So I would just throw that out. I think we do have a couple more meetings before the legislative session begins again. Do we have that as a topic?

My question was if there's going to be 10 or less QHIOS and 1,900 signatories, then, and if a lot of them go to those 10 or less QHIOs, aren't they going to get backed up and not going to meet the deadline.
