

Vision for Data Exchange in California

The Vision for Data Exchange in California

Once implemented across California, the Data Exchange Framework (DxF) will create new connections and efficiencies between health and social services providers, improving whole-person care.

The DxF is California's first-ever statewide Data Sharing Agreement (DSA) that requires the secure and appropriate exchange of health and human services information to enable providers to work together and improve an individual's health and wellbeing.





Who Must Sign the DSA?

#	Required Signatory Type*
1	General acute care hospitals, as defined by Health and Safety Code (HSC) section 1250.
2	Physician organizations and medical groups.
3	Skilled nursing facilities, as defined by HSC section 1250, that currently maintain electronic records.
4	Health care service plans and disability insurers that provide hospital, medical, or surgical coverage that are regulated by the Department of Managed Health Care or the Department of Insurance. This section shall also apply to a <u>Medi-Cal managed care plan under a comprehensive risk contract</u> with the Department of Health Care Services pursuant to Chapter 7 (commencing with Section 14000) or Chapter 8 (commencing with Section 14200) of Part 3 of Division 9 of the Welfare and Institutions Code that is not regulated by the Department of Managed Health Care or the Department of Insurance.
5	Clinical laboratories, as that term is used in Section 1265 of the Business and Professions Code, and that are regulated by the Department of Public Health.
6	Acute psychiatric hospitals, as defined by HSC section 1250.

*Organizations were required to sign by January 31, 2023 regardless of whether they must begin sharing data by January 31, 2024 or January 31, 2026.

Prepare to Meet Data Exchange Expectations

- Ensure your organizations is familiar and preparing to comply with requirements described in the DSA and its P&Ps.
- Understand what information you have to exchange and by when you have to start exchanging (many organizations must begin exchanging by January, 31, 2024)
- Ensure you have the technical capabilities needed to exchange (e.g., by assessing current technology and determining whether you need to upgrade/onboard new technology to meet DxF requirements).
- > Enter your information in the DxF Participant Directory.
- □ Understand the DxF Permitted, Required, and Prohibited Purposes (see P&P)
- □ Understand the Requirement to Exchange Health and Social Services Information (see P&P)
- □ Learn what the Data Elements to Be Exchanged are (see P&P)
- See if you have the technology in place that conforms to the Technical Requirements for Exchange (see P&P)
- Learn about the Participant Directory during today's webinar and by reading the proposed draft P&P.

DEVELOPED BY THE MULTI-ASSOCATION DXF EDUCATION INITIATIVE



LEARN ABOUT THE DXF

Familiarize yourself with the DxF, which includes the Data Sharing Agreement (DSA) and a common set of Policies and Procedures.

TALK TO LEADERSHIP

Reach out to your organization's attorney, privacy officer, and IT managers to understand the Data Sharing Agreement.

PLAN FOR IMPLEMENTATION

Figure out what changes are needed internally for your organization to meet DSA requirements and exchange data, including changes to policies & procedures, technology, and workflows.

MAKE INTERNAL CHANGES NEEDED TO EXCHANGE DATA

Make organizational infrastructure and workflow changes in preparation for data exchange.

CHECK IF YOU'RE A REQUIRED SIGNATORY

Your organization is encouraged to sign the DSA even if you're not currently required.

SIGN THE DSA

Sign via the DSA signing portal.

APPLY FOR FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES (by 12/15/23)


QHIO and TA DSA Signatory grants are available to support data sharing infrastructure across 3 funding rounds. Additional funding is also available for organizations participating in CalAIM ECM/ CS expansion through PATH CITED or IPP.

EXCHANGE DATA IN 2024

Begin exchanging data by January 31, 2024. Some entities (like practices with <25 physicians) have until 2026.

Implementation Toolkit Contents:

- Walks organizations through the process of understanding and signing the DSA through implementing data sharing practices under DxF.
- Outlines internal planning steps related to making changes to internal policies and procedures, technology and workflows.
- Contains questions to ask trading partners to help understand your environment and partners.



DxF this Month

Since our last *Information is Power* webinar on November 7, 2023, CDII & stakeholders have continued to advance DxF implementation across several domains.



DSA P&PCDII has released a number of P&Ps for public comment or as part of a Notice of IntendedDevelopmentAdministrative Changes. More information is available on the DxF webpage.

Round 3 to apply for a DSA Signatory Grant is open! If you have signed the DSA and can demonstrate a health information technology need, you are eligible to apply. Deadline has been extended to December 20th at 11:59pm PT.


Nine Qualified Health Information Organizations were announced in October. CDII is working with these QHIOs to prepare for the start of exchange under the DSA on January 31, 2024.

P&P Development

- Developed 5 new P&Ps (with 2 other P&Ps in the final stages of development)
- Revised several existing P&Ps in response to stakeholder feedback and to ensure consistency across P&Ps
- Developed a Glossary for defined terms used in the DSA and its P&Ps to facilitate stakeholder review and use.

P&Ps in Development

- Early 2024, finalize 2 new P&Ps on
 - Participant Directory
 - Fees
- Finalize administrative modifications to 3 other P&Ps.
- Develop (and/or modify) additional P&Ps, if needs are identified (as governed by the Development of and Modifications to P&Ps P&P).

DSA Signatory Grants


- TA Grantees and QHIOs (on behalf of QHIO Onboarding Grantees) must submit quarterly progress reports.
- TA Grantees are required to achieve Milestone 1 within one year of grant award notification.
- QHIO Onboarding Grantees are required to achieve Milestone 1 as follows:
 - Round 1 and Round 2 grants, within one year of CDII's announcement of QHIOs, so by October 23, 2024.
 - Round 3 grants within one year of CDII's grant award announcement, so may be in CY 2025.

DSA Signatory Grant Milestones

Grantees must achieve Milestone 1 within 12 months and Milestone 2 within 24 months of receiving their award. For Round 1 and 2 QHIO Onboarding Grantees, the 12-month period starts from the QHIO Announcement date.



*TA Grant Awardees should confirm their Milestone due date on the GrantsConnect Portal.

Established phases for Participant Directory implementation

Drafted and posted for Public Comment a Policy and Procedure to establish information needs, and CDII & Participant responsibilities

Looking Ahead 2024

Policy and Procedure

- Complete public comment period on draft P&P
- Publish finalized P&P (anticipated by mid-January)

Participant Directory Implementation, Phase 1

- Add the ability for Participants to add their choices to the Participant Directory in the DSA signing portal
- Participants begin entering choices in the Participant Directory
- Begin to publish Participant choices as additional columns in the listing of DSA signatories (updated weekly)

(Implementation subject to public comments received in the comment period closing December 18, 2023)

Establish Plan for Phase 2



About the Participant Directory

What is the Participant Directory?	New fields in the DSA signing portal and new columns in the list of DSA signatories that informs Participants of the choices other Participants have made in how they share HSSI.
Who enters choices into the Participant Directory?	<u>All Participants</u> . QHIOs and other Intermediaries may advise or assist Participants, but Participants are responsible for their own choices. Participants beginning exchange in 2026 need not enter choices until starting to exchange.
What choices needs to be entered?	 Starting to exchange in 2024 or 2026 Choice for Request for Information Choice for Information Delivery (optional) Choice for Notifications for ADTs (hospitals, EDs)




