A broad coalition of organizations (n= 100+) also recently sent a letter to Congress advocating for the removal of the rider prohibiting HHS from advancing patient health identifier standards. Both of these will go a long way towards addressing the issues related to digital identity and patient matching as it pertains to consent.
